As for the video, it is a 25-second promo video from the Pentagon, which the pundit is selling as “epic”, but which is instead pathetic and transparent. If anything, it proves the plane is a fake. The first half of the video is the plane in a dark hanger, then we cut to some flying footage which is clearly CGI. What? Does that look epic to you? That is the best they can do after decades?
