Alex Constantine and other Fakes

Mike Adams at NaturalNews continues to blow smoke on many topics, doing his job of controlling the opposition like his pal Alex Jones. One way he did that this week was <u>by promoting Alex Constantine</u>, who has been flanking me for years and reselling as real all the events I have blown as fake. Constantine is now old and has been misdirecting since long before I came along, but once I arose he was partially re-assigned to responding to my papers, as anyone can see by following his topics over the past decade.

Constantine is one of thousands of agents in the mold of Ole Dammegard, whose cover I blew here. All of them are hired to appear to be exposing the CIA or other deep state entities, while doing no real harm to those institutions. They accuse the CIA of various forms of skullduggery, most of which were admitted decades ago and which most people already know about, while cleverly reselling all the events of the past as real. NaturalNews was promoting Constantine's new book *Jackals*, for instance, which addresses, among many other things, the Munich Olympics event of 1972 that I blew the cover of here. Constantine can't respond to that directly since 1) he doesn't want to link to me, giving me any more promotion, 2) I am clearly right. So he does what these agents always do: bury a response within a greater discussion, where they can make the event look real simply by *assuming* it is real and working out from there. That assumption of reality is surrounded by a lot of talk that is meant to look revelatory and hard-hitting (but isn't), so it fools the reader into thinking secrets are being revealed and the CIA is being exposed. While just the opposite is actually happening. The reader is being wrapped in blankets and thrown into another set of bushes.

Next Constantine tries to re-hide al-Husseini and Genoud, whom I outed here in my paper on Adam Curtis (p. 17). Constantine outs them as agents (they were already outed), but sells their events as real —and not Jewish. Whereas I show they were Jewish agents whose events were all theater. Given how Constantine is spinning those stories, we may assume he is spinning all the other exposes in the book in similar ways.

Before we continue, you may like to know who Alex Constantine is. No Wiki page and no bio online that I could find. He has zero bio posted on his own website, which is very strange. A Google search pulls up zero images. There are several interviews on youtube, but all are audio only and the voices don't match. But we do find he has worked for the *LA Weekly*, *Z Magazine*, KAZU, and *Mindnet*. Constantine's books have provided the premise for several BBC documentaries—also not a good sign. *LA Weekly* was founded in 1978 by Jay Levin. Jewish. His investment group for that magazine also included Michael Douglas and Burt Kleiner. Wow, not sounding good. <u>Douglas is famous for his films stinking of propaganda</u>. Jay Levin was also the publisher of the *Los Angeles Free Press*—obviously a CIA front paper.

The Freep wrote about and was often directly involved in the major historic issues of the 1960s and 1970s, and with the people who shaped them, including the Chicago Seven, Timothy Leary, Allen Ginsberg, and Abbie Hoffman. Both the famous and the infamous would open up to the Los Angeles Free Press, from Bob Dylan to the Black Panthers to Jim Morrison[3] to Iceberg Slim.

That's from Wiki and tells us all we need to know, doesn't it? <u>I have outed every single</u> one of those people and organizations except Iceberg Slim.

Z Magazine is another obvious CIA front, founded by Michael Albert (Jewish of course) in 1986. He came out of the SDS, which I have outed, and founded South End Press in 1977, which was socialist and linked to Chomsky, Zinn, and the usual cast of agents.

KAZU is an NPR affiliate that has had no volunteers since 2002. It was taken over by Cal State U Monterey Bay long ago, which just happens to be on the former military base Fort Ord. Just a coincidence, I'm sure. CSUMB has only been around since 1995. They might as well rename themselves Cal State Military Base.

One of Constantine's premier jobs seems to be to <u>run interference on the Jewish question</u>, and he is constantly denying the Jews have anything to do with the things he is "unravelling". He is always pointing the finger elsewhere, telling us he is Jewish himself. He also runs interference on 911, <u>see here</u> where he tries to blackwash 911Truth as coming out of Urantia. Really putrid.

Here's something odd I tripped across: there is a younger Alex Constantine who is a Lt. Colonel and Chief of Staff of the Defense Logistics Agency. You will say there is no connection, but this Alex Constantine is also from Monterey, California. Could this be his son? It fits like a glove, doesn't it? In pursuit of that, I ran a people search on both guys. The younger one is Alexander Nicholas Constantine, 44, and his father would appear to be Athan A. Constantine, 80, of Marina, CA, and Hanscom AFB. Could the A. stand for Alex? Probably, so this may be our guy, supposing he exists at all.

But back to his books. His most known book is probably *The Covert War Against Rock*, where he argues the CIA murdered all those famous musicians like Lennon, Morrison and Joplin. Whereas, I have shown they all just faked their deaths, to retire and maximize sales, and to push ahead Operation Chaos. So his theory is 180 degrees from mine. Perhaps even stranger, <u>NaturalNews promoted</u> David Icke's latest book *Children of the Matrix* yesterday, which argues that the reptilian Anunnaki rule the Earth and have done so for millennia. So it isn't the Jews, it is reptilian aliens. Are you seeing a pattern here?

NaturalNews is also promoting this propaganda about China's planned solar array to revolutionize renewable energy. You see what that is about, right? The US wants to get into a fake space war with China in which we can race to see who can spend the most money on invisible projects in space. It is like Trump's new Golden Dome in that regard. Lockheed Martin is looking forward to both projects. But I remind you this conflicts with what Alex Jones' guest Dr. Steven Greer from the Disclosure Project was telling us just last week: world government *already* has unlimited free energy, they just don't want to admit it since it isn't profitable. It is Tesla's old energy, drawn from the Earth/ionosphere, aka zero-point energy. You can pull it right out of the Earth or air, and you don't need to go into space to get it. The Earth is already collecting and channeling and even focusing energy from the Sun, so you don't need mirrors or solar cells to collect it. But though Mike and Alex are working together, they figure you won't be able to spot these inconsistencies across platforms.

And in other news, we find many people are allegedly being swatted, though most of them are employees of Alex Jones. Jones is claiming one of them was murdered by the deep state and they have a contract out on him. All the usual baloney, to get your eyes off other things, keep fear high, push ahead Operation Chaos, and make Jones look real and dangerous.

One of the things they want your eyes off over there is the question "why is Infowars still around at all?" We haven't gotten any updates on the Sandy Hook thing in a long time, have we?
