
## They Just Keep Getting Worse

Just when you though they had bottomed out in Langley, we get this story. Play along and see if you can spot the clues.

August 1: Purple haired Texas mom Ashley Pardo faces charges for allegedly helping her son plan a mass shooting on Rhodes Middle School as way of rewarding him for babysitting, according to the Daily Mail. The school is located in San Antonio, Texas. The 33-year-old mom allegedly "purchased ammunition, tactical gear, and loaded magazines for her [13-year-old] son." Law enforcement indicated the son "drew chilling maps of his school marked 'suicide route,' idolized white supremacist mass shooters, and planned to carry out a massacre." KENS5 noted that Pardo also faces charges of child endangerment-criminal negligence over an incident that occurred on March 3, 2023.

Other than the numerology, where we find not one but two 33's in just a few sentences, and aces and eights in the date, 8/1, we get a reference to the purple people who ran this project—the Phoenicians—and a fake photo. That "photo" is supposed to be from Bexar County Sheriff's Office, but that can't be a booking photo since the lighting is too good and there is no card. San Antonio is known as military town USA. Rhodes Middle School is predominantly Hispanic, but Ashley Pardo isn't a lower-class Hispanic name. Pardo is a Jewish name, think famous announcer Don Pardo, and Rhodes is a top peerage name. Whatever she is, Pardo clearly isn't white, so how could her son be a white supremacist? Hispanic boys can't be white supremacists by definition. They are either testing you here or just don't care anymore. There is now some sort of default setting on the fake events, where the computer just spits out two a week based on juggling prior input somehow.

According to Radaris, Ashley's father Jesse Pardo works in airport security, though we aren't told how high up he is. Taking that info to LinkedIN, we find him working for JFK, I suppose JFK airport, and Allied Barton, San Antonio. That's another big red flag, since Allied Barton is a spooky company, probably a CIA front (but what isn't?), being the largest privately held security company in the US. It was owned by Blackstone until 2015, and Wendel after that. Wendel is run by major French spook

Laurent Mignon, also COB of Bureau Veritas and formerly of BPCE (huge French bank). He is also on the board of many other major companies.

Ashley's aunt Edna married an Arce and through them is related to Kruegers, so we have the expected Jewish connection. Her in-law Carrie Anne Krueger is aka Carrie Lapinski. Aka Dan Glassing, same age, so probably not a mistake for her husband. Maybe a tranny. I didn't find her listed under any of those names at LinkedIN. She links us to Aaron Valentine Arce, 42, which is a red-flag name. She also links to a Rudy Aleman, and he works as a correctional officer at Texas Department of Criminal Justice, which you have to admit is suspicious, since it gives us a hard link. Ashley has inside connections, telling me they may have tapped her for her looks to front this Operation Chaos project. She already has the face tats, so just slap a purple wig on her and they are done.

More digging finds these Pardos of San Antonio related to Castros. Ashley has a sister named Jessica Pardo, aka Lozoya, 32, but she is not listed at Instantcheckmate. We do find her at Radaris, mother Rita Ortiz/Arce. The boy's father or uncle may be Mario Porras, 32, also of Hanover, MD, and San Bernardino, CA. The Porras family in San Antonio is not poor, they are wealthy and prominent, see for example Rick Porras, producer of the *Lord of the Rings* movies. So as usual none of this is adding up. So far they haven't told us much, like how they caught the kid or why they were tracking him. They are holding back his name and image due to his age, I guess. They also don't tell us how they know she bought all that stuff for the kid and not for herself. Until he used it, there would be no proof of that one way or another, unless she took the time to write down that she bought it for the kid so he could blow up the school. Which of course she would never do. And who pays a kid for babysitting with hundreds of rounds of ammo? You give the kid a twenty, or if you are really rich maybe you buy him some new Jordans. You don't drop a grand on ammo and tactical gear. But I guess AI doesn't know that.
