The Olympics Looks Faker Every Time

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I was going to boycott the Olympics due to the opening ceremonies—and for other reasons—but it is always on at the pub, so it is hard to miss. Today I was unfortunate enough to see the women's 400m hurdles, which has been hyped for months. Sydney McLaughlin versus Femke Bol. I know about Bol since she looks vaguely like my ex-wife. I have seen some of her races on youtube and know the scoop. It should have been a great race, but it wasn't. Bol is a great runner but a terrible actress, and she really blew this one, probably on purpose. I think she was paid to stand down, but she was probably instructed to lose narrowly, making it look real. Instead she quit before the last hurdle and didn't even get second, slowing into the finish line.

I will be told she bonked, being a bad finisher. Right. When has that ever happened? She is one of the greatest finishers in history, and passed the other world-class girls in the 4x400 mixed relay in this Olympics in the last 30 meters like they were standing still. I thought she might have been sick, but in comments after the race she didn't mention anything, just saying she had gone out too fast. Bad lie, Femke, since she didn't go out too fast. If anything, she went out slow, since McLaughlin had caught her by the third hurdle. Bol ran a 50.95 just a few months ago, close to McLaughlin's WR, but today she ran a 52.15, 1.2 seconds slower. And that while racing McLaughlin, which should have speeded her up. So this whole thing looked staged to me. I think Bol was giving us the clue by finishing third and not even trying. Did anyone but me get it?

And why would they pay her to stand down? Because McLaughlin can make them much more money in the US than Bol can make them in Holland. Bol is a poor investment. Plus, this isn't the time of the blonde white girl, as you know. With McLaughlin's admittedly smashing good looks, the sky is the limit on shoe sales, track gear, etc. They weren't about to let Bol jeopardize that gravy train.

In researching this, I was quickly taken down the usual rabbit hole. Most searches on Bol lead to a video of her talking like Minnie Mouse, and even <u>Sports Illustrated</u> has republished it as genuine. But it's not. It's fake. She doesn't talk like that, as she proved <u>in her Paris interview</u> after this race. She has a nice normal voice. So why would <u>Sports Illustrated</u>, Bing, MSN, <u>The Mirror</u>, <u>The Sun</u>, <u>The New</u>

York Post, and Google promote this fraud? I just told you: Bol is a bad investment and they don't want you pulling for her.

Did we see the same thing with Karsten Warholm of Norway and Rai Benjamin? It was less obvious since Warholm is a slightly better actor, but I have never seen Warholm die like that at the end of a race. He pretends to hit the wall but it isn't very convincing. Warholm ran a 47:06, which is way off what he ran in Tokyo: 45:94. And again, you would expect Rai to win in a squeaker, not to trounce Warholm by .6. It is immediately suspicious to see all these small-country runners dying to Americans, in races they have never before died in.

The bad loss by Ingebrigtsen of Norway in the 1500m was also suspicious, since he also allegedly hit the wall—something he never does. He fell to fourth, out of the medals, which I again see as a clue he left for us. In an interview afterwards, he said he went out too fast, but he has run hundreds of these big races and never done this before. You can see him watching the clock early in the race, so what happened? He forgot how to tell time? Plus, if Ingebrigtsen couldn't finish at 1500m, explain to me how he won the 5000m a few days later, destroying everyone in the final lap? The way he lost at 1500m was also suspicious, since we see short, bandy-legged American Cole Hocker pass Ingebrigtsen on the inside, something Ingebrigtsen should have never let him do, and which is illegal anyway. A runner isn't allowed to push through on the inside like that and is expected to pass on the outside. In passing you aren't allowed to slap arms, so there has to be a large enough gap there to pass with doing that. But for some reason Ingebrigtsen *moves over* and let's Hocker pass him on the inside on the final straight. I couldn't believe it. There had to be a pay off for that. Is Hocker Jewish? Of course. He is dating Sarah Levy, managing editor at *Hey Alma*, a Jewish culture mag.

[Added August 22: Just two weeks later, Ingebrigtsen blew Hocker off the track in a rematch in Lausanne, winning pulling away at the end, by 10 meters or two full seconds. They are trying to explain that because there was a pacer in the event, but I ain't buying it.]

Another one that looked fake was the 400m men's race, where Quincy Hall won in an obvious stand down. He falls down on the track afterwards, looking up at the Lord as if the Lord gives a shit, and when the camera comes over to him, he points to his shoes like one of the ladies on the Price is Right. I couldn't believe it. I am just surprised they didn't have a Home Shopping Network picture-in-picture, or a link to Amazon. In this one it was Jareem Richards of Trinidad who was the worst actor, since he was running away with it at the midway point. Hall was five meters back and wagging his head like he was about to puke, but suddenly in the last 50 meters everyone but Hall slowed to a crawl. In the men's 200m, we didn't see a stand down, though I suspect it was ordered. Tebogo of Botswana was probably ordered to pull up, but didn't. Lyles of the US—who had predicted a win—pretended to have been sick, leaving the track afterwards in a wheelchair, but Tebogo ran a 19.46 and would have beaten him anyway. Lyles hasn't run that fast since 2022. Lyles' best time in 2023-4 was 19.52. Tebogo was priceless in the interview afterwards, giving a tacit F-you to the Phoenicians. When asked if he was the new face of the 200, he said he didn't think he could be the face of sports, since he wasn't arrogant or loud enough. You have to laugh.

We already saw Alex Walsh screwed in swimming in favor of Kaylee McKeown, though we aren't sure why. A bronze isn't worth much for merchandizing purposes, since audiences are used to being wowed by fake golds. Besides, McKeown already had two golds and a silver, so this bronze would seem to be

meaningless. I suspect the Kohens simply can't let any opportunity pass.

You will say "What?" Well, Keown=Kohen, my friends. Wikipedia tells us McKeown comes from the Irish MacEoin, which is pronounced like McOwen. But it is also pronounced like McKohen, and the Mac prefix is Scots, not Irish. The Irish prefix is O'. This indicates they came over to Ireland from Scotland, and Wikipedia admits some other researchers have proposed the same thing. So I looked up the McKeowns in the peerage. They are there but exceedingly well scrubbed. The McKeowns of County Down married the Forsyths in 1862, also Scottish. <u>See the Forsyth daughters of that time and family who went back to Scotland to marry</u>.

So, when Wikipedia says there is no evidence the McKeowns were Scottish, they are just lying:

This claim is difficult to substantiate, due to poor church or state records during the plantation period.

You mean the poor records I just pulled up on an easy free websearch?

Kaylee McKeown comes from Queensland, so she is a descendent of Samuel McKeown, who came over in about 1860. You may be interested to know that he married Laura **Dahl**, Dahl being a Jewish name, think Roald Dahl. She later married Thomas Quirk, who just happened to be from. . . Isle of Man, b. 1841. Kaylee's father is named Sholto, which is a big clue here. It links them to the Sholto Douglases of Scotland, Barons of Kirtleside. The 1st Baron William Sholto Douglas was Marshal of the RAF during WWII, becoming Commander of the British Occupation after the war. He wasn't raised to the peerage for that, since the Sholto Douglases were peerage before him. Unfortunately thepeerage.com scrubs them, refusing to tell us where they came from. With a bit more digging, we find they come from West Sussex in the late 1700s, where they were closely related to the Douglases, Marquesses of Queensbury. In the early 1800s they moved to Hobart Town, which gets us close to

Queensland. We can also look at Edward Sholto Douglas-Pennant, 3rd Baron Penrhyn and brother-inlaw of Edward Fitzroy, a descendant in direct line of Charles II. He is most interesting for his portrait:



Obviously Jewish. Kaylee also looks Jewish, and her Mom has a Habsburg jaw, so it would be interesting to know her maiden name.




