Fake Death in Malibu

The Rory Sykes story

Just this morning I came across this story and it is what started me writing. It was on the Fox News website this morning, here: https://www.foxnews.com/entertainment/rory-sykes-former-child-star-dead-32-from-california-fires

His mother says he died in the Palisades Fire on January 8. (Note the date. Aces and eights, of course.) He was a former child actor who was born blind and with cerebral palsy, and who later became a motivational speaker and formed a charity.

Look closely at that second pic above. For someone who is supposed to be blind, he sure is good at staring right at the camera.

According to his IMDB-page (which has already been updated with his death – who on Earth does that? - it's macabre...), Rory, his mother Shelley Sykes, and grandmother all share the same birthday, July 29, 1992, 1962 and 1944 respectively." Which is possible but extremely rare. Seems like a signal, though, and you will think so even more in moment.

His mother writes on X:

"It is with great sadness that I have to announce the death of my beautiful son <u>@Rorysykes</u> to the Malibu fires yesterday. I'm totally heart-broken. British born Australian living in America, a wonderful son, a gift born on mine & his grandmas birthday 29 July 92, Rory Callum Sykes. <u>*a*rorysykes</u> was the founder with me of <u>*a*happycharity</u> a true humanitarian. He saw him self as the number one fan of <u>@Apple</u> & <u>@tim_cook</u> & most importantly an avid <u>@RuneScape</u> gamer! @rorysykes was born blind with cerebral palsy & had difficulty walking. He overcame so much with surgeries & therapies to regain his sight & to be able to learn to walk. Despite the pain, he still enthused about traveling the world with me from Africa to Antarctica. <u>@rorysykes</u> was a sought after inspirational speaker for <u>@TonyRobbins</u> when he was only 8 years old. @CallumsCure book first published by <u>@simonschuster</u> in Australia was about his courage. @rorysykes had his own cottage on our 17 acre Mount Malibu TV Studio estate, decked out with all the latest apple gadgets, which burnt down yesterday 8 Jan 2024 Malibu Fires. I couldn't put out the cinders on his roof with a hose because the water was switched off by <u>@LVMWD</u> Las Virgenes Municipal Water. Even the 50 brave fire fighters had no water all day! He will be incredibly missed by <u>@shelleysykes</u>, mama his pet peacocks Edgee & Mickie & all his online fans around the world!"

So his mother is able to write a lengthy text on social media about her son's death the very next day. She takes the time to plug and link to all sorts of organizations, which I find strange, because it takes time, you have to think, and promoting Apple and Tim Cook would be the last thing on my mind if I had just lost my son. She also links to herself at the end which is the weirdest thing ever. Who does that?

She couldn't put out the cinders on his roof with a hose because there was no water, couldn't move him because her arm was broken, couldn't call 911 because the phone lines were down (you can read that on Fox News), went to the fire station where they told her even the firefighters had no water, drove back to her property with firefighters and found her son's cottage burnt to the ground. They know he died of carbon monoxide poisoning although they still haven't recovered his body. He is missed by his peacocks.

So she knew that in an emergency she wouldn't be able to move him, as she has extensive experience travelling with her son, so she knows of the difficulties. But she stayed on her property with him although the situation was getting more and more dangerous. Who in their right mind would do this? Why not leave sooner?

Also, she had not noticed that the water had been completely turned off, because she tried to use a hose. So she and her son had both not used any tap water over the last hours?

[January 15: the local water authority, Las Virgenes, has since refuted her story, saying the municipal water was never cut or lost for that area.]

Neighbours didn't come and offer help, although they must have known her, they must have known her son couldn't walk and maybe they even knew her arm was broken. All the neighbours left without checking on her first? Really? She didn't go and ask them to help her get her son in a car? Really?

She couldn't lift him because of her broken arm. So with an unbroken arm she could have lifted him? When I look at the picture of them both, I don't believe that: She is much smaller than him and doesn't look strong. There is no way she could lift a big man like that. Apparently, he didn't even own a wheelchair and was completely reliant on his mother to move him. So he didn't have an assistant like a nurse or something? His mother did all that work alone? Also note that him being totally reliant on his mother contradicts what she writes on X where she says that he "had difficulty walking" and "he had been able to learn to walk". But he couldn't even get into his wheelchair or walk to his mother's car? And on the other hand, she was able to use a hose and drive a car with a broken arm? She couldn't call 911 because the lines were down. So she and her son both didn't own a cell phone? Although she says that his home was "decked out with all the latest Apple gadgets"?

That blows the story by itself.

Also, what were the firefighters doing at the fire station when she got there? Were they sitting around playing cards and waiting for the water to be turned back on? Shouldn't they have been busy doing at least something, like driving around and trying to warn people? Why was someone even there who was willing to drive back with her?

When she got back, the house was already burned to the ground. Which means that she really had waited till the last moment before she left that place and went to find help. Who does that? You see fire aproaching from far away, you can smell it. There would have been smoke in the air. When it was that close, it should have been difficult to breathe there. I can't picture someone waiting and then at the last minute stupidly trying to use a garden hose.

What is also really strange is this: They were able to drive back to the property. So the fire had advanced across the property, had burned everything down and had already moved on, and the firefighters who went back with her thought it was safe to do so? They drove towards the blazing fire with her? Their wheels didn't melt on the hot asphalt?

They haven't recovered his body but they know what he died of. How? Even if you find a totally charred corpse inside the ruin of a burned house, you don't know for sure that he died of CO poisoning, do you? But they know.

Oh, and his peacocks survived and are able to miss him now. How did they do that, being on the property that was totally burned down?

His website <u>https://www.rorysykes.com/</u> is just an empty page with the words "Gamer, Investor, Philanthropist". - Interesting job description.

When I search for pictures of him, I find only one picture of him with his mother on the whole internet. Plus very few childhood pictures. Shouldn't there be more?

On Shelley Sykes's X it says: "Studio Head, Mother of <u>@RorySykes</u>. Get Syked for Life! Syking People Up Worldwide with TV Shows, Books, Music & Seminars for Happier more Productive

Lives."

Interesting job description. What does she even mean, "syking people up"? Like "psyching" people up?

Fireproof Art & Culture

In this article it says that two sites of cultural significance for Germany, the Thomas-Mann-House and the Villa Aurora, have been spared by the fires. These places are where Thomas Mann and Lion Feuchtwanger respectively lived during their exile.

The Wikipedia entry for "Villa Aurora" has already been updated and says that the 2025 fires in Pacific Palisades have not damaged the building.

Pictures

Some of the pictures and video footage from the fires seem weird. As Miles pointed out, it looks like everything burned to white. Also a lot of trees and shrubbery seem to be unharmed. Also I noticed several pictures and videos that showed a single building that seemed to be burning from the inside out. I mean there was more fire inside than outside. Of course it could be that everything outside had already burned away, and now only the house was left to burn. But if everything around it burned away quickly, then how did the house catch fire? Why does it look like almost no walls remain standing? Are these houses completely made from wood? A German friend said to me: "They only use wood in LA, because it's so warm, so of course that's a huge fire hazard." - But is that really true? I can't imagine a house built with no bricks, unless it's a log cabin...

No, there's a lot of stucco/adobe in LA and Palisades. Most roof shingles don't burn. Metal doesn't burn. But I guess AI doesn't know that, so these fake burns are just white ash. Mel Gibson supposedly lost everything in a \$15 million home, but he doesn't seem too concerned. It's all replaceable, he says. Really? So no irreplaceable art, Mel? No irreplaceable photos? No antiques? Just a bunch of junk from IKEA, I guess.

Then there were videos of the fires seen from the air, which showed like lines of fire in the darkness, as if a thin line of fire was running through the woods. I found that really strange

because wouldn't a wildfire spread from a single place and then expand in the direction of the wind? And cover a growing area? What I saw looked more like a fuse had been laid through the woods and then lit. - That is just a theory because that is how it looked to me.

I thought the same thing, because it looks like there are unburned trees both behind and in front of the line of fire. It doesn't work like that, but again maybe they didn't feed AI all the necessary information.

Then there were the things Miles already pointed out, the selective burning, with houses completely burned to the ground and the house next to them not even blackened by soot or ash. That is very strange. I have experienced a fire burning inside a house, and the house didn't even burn down, just the one room where the fire started was completely destroyed. But still the house (a big one) was covered in BLACK soot on the inside from the lowest level (where the fire had smouldered behind a closed door until firefighters put it out after four hours) to the top (three stories above). And I remember seeing soot dripping down the stairs and forming puddles quite far away from the fire and wondering where this BLACK liquid was coming from. So when you burn stuff that isn't just wood but mattresses and synthetic fibres and plastic (which you would have in a household), the fire cannot burn with a clean flame, but will produce plenty of smoke and soot. And that is what I experienced with just one room burning. No one could enter the house any more because dense smoke was coming out of all the entries and even between the roof shingles. And later you couldn't touch anything without getting your hands dirty.

Yes, that reminds us houses are full of plastics, and plastics don't form white ash. Those fake photos we are being fed by AI also lack the signatures of burned plastics, as I mentioned in my paper on Lahaina.

Shelley Sykes has no relatives listed in the people searches except Rory. Her IMDB bio says she came out of the London Regent School of Acting, so she is an actor here. She has also worked in banking and for IBM. Her mother is Pauline Lowe, which may link her to John Kerry and Rob Lowe. Being a Lowe and a Sykes may link Rory to the Sykes baronets and Admiral Ashmore. Through the Liddells we may link to President Biden.

She and Rory were allegedly living on Mount Malibu TV Studio. Note that: the report of this death comes from a TV studio. No such place is listed <u>but you can find it at IMDB</u>, where it turns out to be a beachfront mansion for the superwealthy, site of the *Get Syked with Style* TV show, which apparently aired 24 episodes somewhere. I encourage you to take that link and watch that clip, to see who we are dealing with here. There are no reports of those huge beachfront mansions burning down, so we are supposed to believe the fire just moved in and targeted Rory's little "bungalow" and then nicely moved on. Seeing the amount of wealth here again confirms Sykes must be connected to huge wealth, probably the Baronet Sykes or other peerage lines. If you still want to believe what these people are telling you about anything, that's on you.

In that line, it is interesting that one of these Sykes in the peerage was Sir Richard Sykes, b. 1920, who became a major and then joined the Foreign Office. He worked at the British Embassy in DC before he ended up being the UK ambassador to the Netherlands. We are supposed to believe he

was murdered by the IRA in The Hague in 1979. I know that isn't true since <u>I have shown you</u> the IRA is a British front and the whole thing has been staged from the beginning. Same thing we are seeing now in the Middle East with Hamas and Hezbollah. All war and terrorism theater. IRA claimed responsiblity a year later, but no one was ever arrested or even sought. What does this prove? It proves the Sykes have been involved in high level fakery for a long time.

And where did these Sykes get their money? Phoenician Navy, of course. The 1st baronet was East India Company, being a governor in India.

Having joined the British East India Company, Sykes amassed a fortune in Bengal at the court of the Nawab. He became the Governor of Cossimbazar. During his time in India, he became good friends with both Warren Hastings and Lord Clive.

I also remind you of Colonel Sir Mark Sykes, 6th Baronet, who we saw in my paper on Lawrence of Arabia. His full name was Tatton Benvenuto Mark Sykes and his mother was a Cavendish-Bentinck, linking us to those superwealthy Dukes of Portland—possibly telling us where Shelley Sykes money comes from, in part. Her maiden name is hidden, as are her father and husband. She really doesn't want you to know where she came from.
